

Divided Sweets Box

Looking for small gifts for those special friends for the holidays? Whether it's sweets or some little gift, I have the perfect little box to hold whatever you want to gift!



SUPPLIES

Stamp Set: Nothing Sweeter (p – 147773)

Ink:

Real Red Classic Ink (147084)

Paper (including cutting dimensions):

Whisper White Thick Card Stock [CS] (140272) 6" x 6"; 1" x 1"

Real Red Card Stock [CS] (102482) 5 1/2" x 4"; 5 1/2" x 2"; 3" x 3"; 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Santa's Workshop Specialty Designer Series Paper Red and White Stripe [DSP] (147809) 5 9/16" x 5 9/16"

Window Sheets (142314) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

Layering Squares Framelits Dies (141708)

3/4" Circle Punch (119873)

1 1/8" Scallop Circle Punch (146138)

Real Red 3/8" Mixed Satin Ribbon (147894) 14"

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Score the Whisper White Thick CS which is the box base at 1" on all 4 sides. Fold on score lines and cut up on one side of each corner on the score line to the 1" mark. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive on each tab and assemble the box
2. Score the striped Santa's Workshop at $\frac{3}{4}$ " on each side. This is the lid of the box.
3. Using the Square Layering Framelits Die (#6 from the smallest – 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ ") cut out the center of the Santa's Workshop DSP. TIP: To get the center exactly mark on the backside with a pencil from each corner diagonally. Where the pencil marks meet, is the center. Line up the square framelit and cut using the Big Shot.
4. Using the Square Scallop Framelit (#7 from the smallest – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "), line up the #6 square and #7 scallop and cut out a frame in Real Red CS
5. Adhere the frame to the square cut out on the Santa's Workshop DSP with Multipurpose Liquid Glue
6. Add some Tear & Tape Adhesive to the Window Sheet and adhere it to the back of the cut out
7. Assemble the Santa's Workshop DSP by cutting one score line to the $\frac{3}{4}$ " score line and adding Tear & Tape Adhesive to the tabs and assembling the lid
8. Stamp the sentiment on Whisper White CS and cut out with the $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle punch. Cut out the Real Red CS using the 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " Scallop Circle Punch.
9. Adhere the sentiment to the scallop circle and to the lid with a Stampin' Dimensional.
10. Score the Real Red CS 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" on one end of the 4" side at 2". Turn and score at 2" on the opposite end. Flip the paper over and score at 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Fold on the center score line and burnish well. Fold the 2" score lines and make a "W". Do this also with the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" piece. Burnish the score lines well. Add the large piece of CS to the inside of the box and the small one on the right side. They can be adhered down with Tear & Tape, but it's not necessary. (Picture 3)
11. Tie the Real Red $\frac{3}{8}$ " Mixed Satin Ribbon in a bow and adhere to the front of the box with a Mini Glue Dot
